Some Thoughts Of Pope Francis: Be the sovereign of yourself.

Do not wait to convert to the Lord. Do not put off changing your life. If you know you have flaws, stop for a moment before going to bed and examine your conscience. Take the horse by the reins; you are in charge. Tell yourself: yes, I made a mistake. I failed multiple times, I did not succeed on many occasions, but tomorrow I do not want it to happen again. It is important to be aware of your own personal failures. We all have them, every day, a multitude of them. Do not be afraid but do not let them become habitual. If I take the reins of this passion, I will be in charge. I will be responsible for my actions. It only takes five minutes before going to bed to learn to become a better "sovereign" of myself the following day. Start by asking: What happened today? What happened in my soul? Let us examine our conscience every day in order to convert to the Lord. We can conclude by promising ourselves that "Tomorrow I will try not to do that again." Of course it might happen again but maybe to a lesser degree. Eventually you will be able to govern yourself and not be governed by your passions, by all the ongoing events of your life. It only takes a few minutes at the end of every day.




