They respond to callouts from An Garda Síochána, Irish Coast Guard, and the families of missing people. This service is free of charge. We began our support for this charity with €1,650.

Tax Back 2025

As one comes to the end of another year, we look forward to the next. It is time to first of all thank those parish members who participated in our Tax Back Program for 2024. These are difficult financial times for everyone, church included, and I would like to acknowledge, and thank, the effort made by those members who participated in our Tax Back program for 2024.

We are a small parish and yet during 2023, at no cost to ourselves, we received back from the tax man €16.633.65. It makes a big difference to our overall income and gives us the freedom to consider possible development options for the parish.

So now we are getting ready for 2025. We are appealing to new members paying tax to consider joining our Tax Back program for 2025. It will not in any way inconvenience a person or draw any attention to a person's financial story.

All that is required is for a person paying tax: they register their name and consent to being part of the program. The person receives a box of envelopes for each Sunday of the year; all that is required is that by the end of 2025 the total amount of contributions received by the church exceeds €250.

The more a person contributes, the more the church receives back from the tax man, if the person does not exceed the €250, that person's name cannot be submitted.
